- 2. Upcoming events and reminders

b. Updates on boundary and regional magnet program changes from Sarah Edelman. Here's the basic timeline of where we are: MCPS put out three new options in the latest survey. December is for community feedback. February 5th superintendent will make final recommendations. February & March BOE will hear input and vote on a final choice in March.

Two things to note: Two options increase the FARM share and ELL populations at TPMS. Eastern option decreases the FARM rate from 70% to 50%

- c. EBB update for Ms. Bodre-Woods Currently taking applications from staff and others who want to be part of program. They're gonna start with 96 students grade 2-5. Started with students 10 15 points from being on grade level. EBB reaching out to families; Invited students will begin the first weeks of February.
- d. Updates on Community School activities from Ms. Gray
 - i. Parenting Classes are starting soon. Ms. Gray would like us to help get the word out about the parenting classes. There's incentives for parents who complete the course.
 - Steering committee getting off the ground at ESS. To meet first year community school goals. PTA can help support by helping us collect or input data. Needs assessment will be complete by end of May, early June.
 - iii. December 17, parent-coffee to preview parenting classes
